Its purpose is to give talented young students an opportunity to perform and to work with master teachers.

THE GCSS MUSIC COMPETITION XI, 2026 Competition Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be residents of the state of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, and Mississippi, or be studying with a teacher who is a resident of these states. Competition participants will be students from Elementary, Middle School, High School and Undergraduate Colleges and Universities in the five-state region.

THE GCSS MUSIC COMPETITION XI, 2026 Competition Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be residents of the state of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, and Mississippi, or be studying with a teacher who is a resident of these states. Competition participants will be students from Elementary, Middle School, High School and Undergraduate Colleges and Universities in the five-state region.

- Category A: Elementary School (Grade 1-5) or yearly age
- Category B: Middle School (Grade 6-8)
- Category C: High School TWO LEVELS: (Grade 9-10) and (Grade 11-12)
- College Level Category (undergraduate students only) TWO LEVELS: Freshman-Sophomore and Junior-Senior
- Previous Winners of First, Second, and Third Place from 2025 are not eligible to compete in the same category in 2026.
- Carnegie Hall Participation: This competition is only for students who are willing and able to perform at Carnegie Hall. If a student is not planning to participate in the winners' recital, they should not apply, as they will be disqualified.

AWARDS

Three Gulf Coast Steinway Society Awards will be given for each category. Honorable Mentions will be given at the discretion of the judges.

Contemporary Music Prize

SOLO REPERTOIRE THREE WORKS

Students will perform a minimum TWO contrasting styles.

Elementary, Middle, High Schools:

- Maximum duration for the THREE works combined: 12 minutes
- Maximum duration for each individual work: 5 minutes

College Level:

- Maximum duration for the THREE works combined: 15 minutes
- Maximum duration for each individual work: 6 minutes

PARTICIPANT WILL RECEIVE A SCHEDULE BY EMAIL

All works must be memorized. You must provide ONE copy of your score.

SCORES MUST BE LEGALLY DOWNLOADED

APPLICATIONS DUE

Applications must be submitted by Friday, December 12, 2025. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

STUDENT APPLICATION FEE
