Steve Dunn is Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Symphonic Winds at the University of Mobile. He has degrees from Jacksonville State University (BA in Music, brass performance) and the University of New Mexico (MM, composition), and has done additional graduate study in church music at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

For more than 25 years, Steve established himself as an expert in the area of church instrumental music and has long been in demand as a guest conductor/clinician (choral and instrumental), author, speaker and teacher for schools, churches, universities and various conferences at the local, state and national level. Since moving to the University of Mobile in 2012, he has built a growing reputation as conductor in the educational realm as well.

As a composer/arranger/orchestrator, Steve has approximately 250 works in the catalogs of numerous publishing houses. These include works for concert band, orchestra, choir and other mixed ensembles.
